### **PARENTS OF AUN SCHOOLS ACADEMY**

We are open to parents' review and support and we appreciate all our esteemed parents for their support and patronage.

- Parents are to present report on any student with medical appointment or concerns to the Management on or before resumption date. This is to enable the school plan the review of such student(s) while on campus.
- The school has well-equipped and qualified medical personnel to handle health-related issues. Henceforth, exit request on health ground must be supported with a medical report from recognized and accredited hospitals.

### **Early WAEC Sitting (Pre-SS3 WAEC Sitting)**

- We wish to intimate parents on the need to henceforth disallow children/wards from sitting for SSCE while in SSS II.
- Parents are encouraged to allow children/wards to complete their secondary school course work before conveniently sitting for the SSCE in SSS III. It goes without saying that students who sit for the SSCE while in SSS II and thereafter proceed to the university, do so with the deficit of SSS III course work not covered. The Management of AUN Schools – Academy wishes to herewith unequivocally inform parents that testimonials and recommendation letters will not be provided for students who sit for the SSCE while in SSS II and thereafter wish to proceed to the university. Certainly, the sought university will request for such important documents from the school, which will not be provided by the school as such students did not complete the school programme.

### **Late Resumption/Early Departure**

- Parents are **STRONGLY** encouraged to allow their children/wards resume on the stipulated dates.
- Continuous assessment tests will be organized within the first and second week of resumption; weekly quizzes will also be organized within the first and second week of resumption. These forms over 20% of C.A; and attendance which forms 10% will also be taken. We therefore urge parents to ensure that their children resume promptly as the Management will not condone late resumption.
- Parents should not book returning tickets for their children/wards earlier than the school's closing date as contained in the school's calendar.
- Parents are strongly admonished to take advantage of the school calendar and plan with it. The school will not entertain any distracting request henceforth.
- Picking any child/ward from the airport with the school bus after 25th April, 2021 will attract a charge of N5000 (at the expense of parents) as agreed at the PTF.

## BOARDERS

- We wish to inform parents that no member of staff is allowed to keep money for students. Parents who therefore wish to buy anything for children in school should send money to the school account and inform the school for an official delegation to be made for the purchase of the item for the child/ward.
- The Management also wishes to notify parents that no student is allowed to solicit for funds from parents for any programme or event in school. If there is any need to solicit for funds for any function, the Management will send letters on the school's letter-headed paper which would be duly signed by the Director, AUN Schools.

## Cell Phone

- Students resuming with phone MUST submit such phone to the school management, otherwise, the phone will be confiscated and not returned to the student. Should parents wish to contact the hostel or leave a message during the school day, it is best to contact the Principal or Vice Principal Administration.
- Mofti: students are to resume with four (4) moftis; two (2) social wears and two (2) event wears.
